# DETAILS ABOUT CAMPS 1 AND 2

STUDENTS AGES 5-11 (ENTERING GRADES K-5)

**THE MORNING** gives students direct instruction in vocal and physical characterization, theatrical terms and concepts, and offers the opportunity to devise their own theatrical productions through play, improvisation, and storytelling.

**THE AFTERNOON** brings age- and experience-appropriate workshops in art, movement, and music. Each hands-on workshop gives students the opportunity to explore techniques, important people, and other topics in each area.

**CAMP 1** (ages 5-7) offers friendly instruction in theatre, art, movement, and music in a supportive environment using the Playhouse's unique and successful arts-integration approach. Each week is based on a different theme-- this makes it possible for students to attend one week or multiple weeks!

**CAMP 2** (ages 8-11) continues and extends the work done in Camp 1, though experience is not required.

*Each week, students will imagine and explore a different facet of the summer's overall theme. The week will culminate in a showcase performance for friends and family.*

**Tuition: \$300 per week\*\*\***

# DETAILS ABOUT THE UPPER CAMP

STUDENTS AGES 12-14 (ENTERING GRADES 6-8)

Students in this two-week, full-day camp are ready to accelerate a little more, though they will still adapt and write scripts connecting to each session's themes. Camp activities will focus on vocal and physical acting and how strong choices on a performer's part in these areas can help to make a strong impression on the audience. Additionally, they will design and realize their own set, lights, and costumes as well as helping with bringing showcases to life for Camps 1 and 2. The extended camp session provides time for increased script comprehension and more time to rehearse and refine **the showcase production, available to friends and family at the conclusion of the second week of camp!**

**Tuition: \$500 per two-week session\*\*\***
