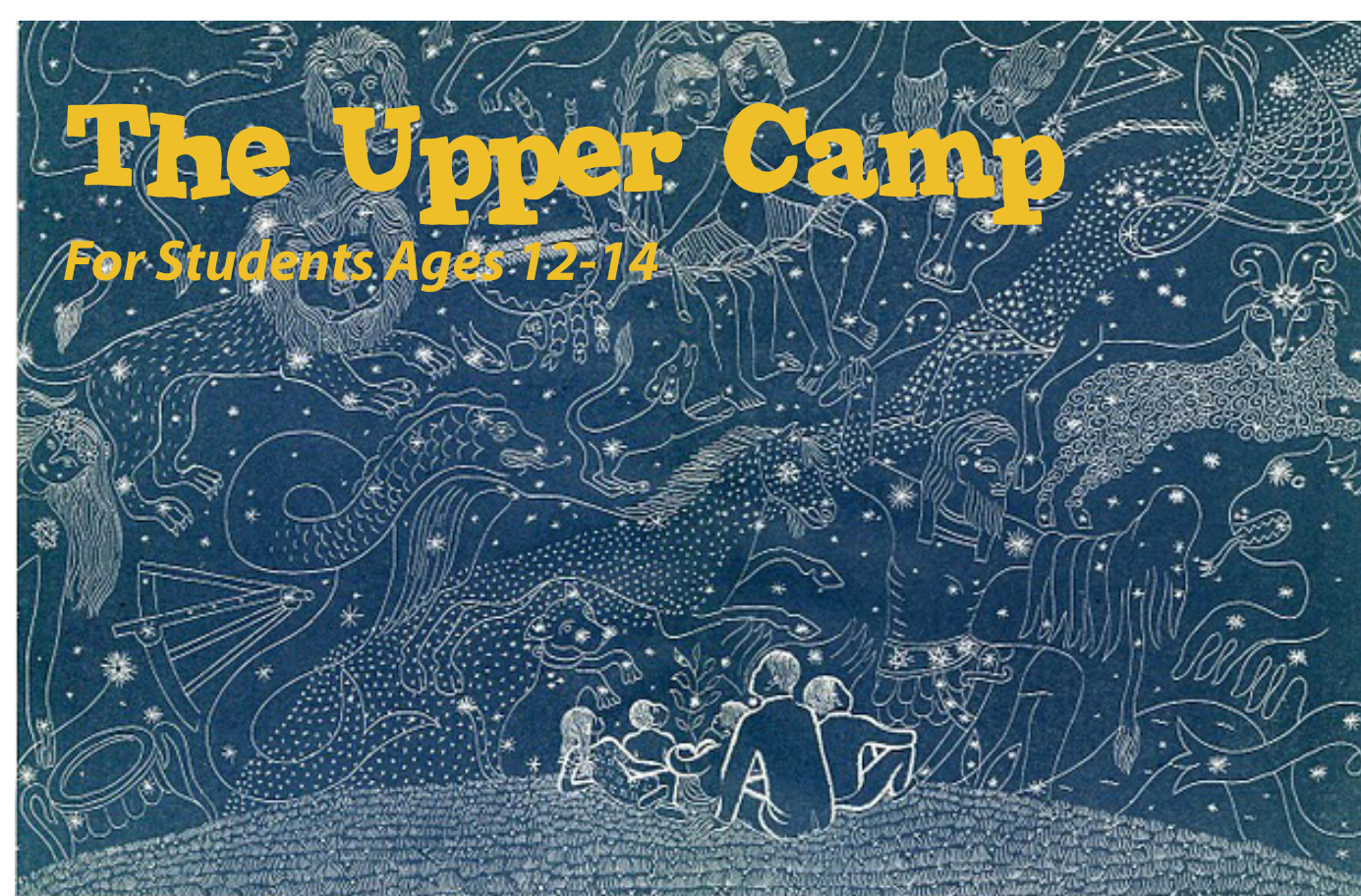

For Students Ages 12-14 (entering grades 6-8)

Students in this two-week, full-day camp focus on vocal and physical acting and how strong choices on a performer's part in these areas can help to make a strong impression on the audience. Students in this camp group will also have the chance to benefit from the knowledge of some of the professional artists working at the Playhouse through workshops offered at the end of the first week. The extended camp session provides more time to rehearse and refine the final showcase production, presented to friends and family on the final Friday of camp!

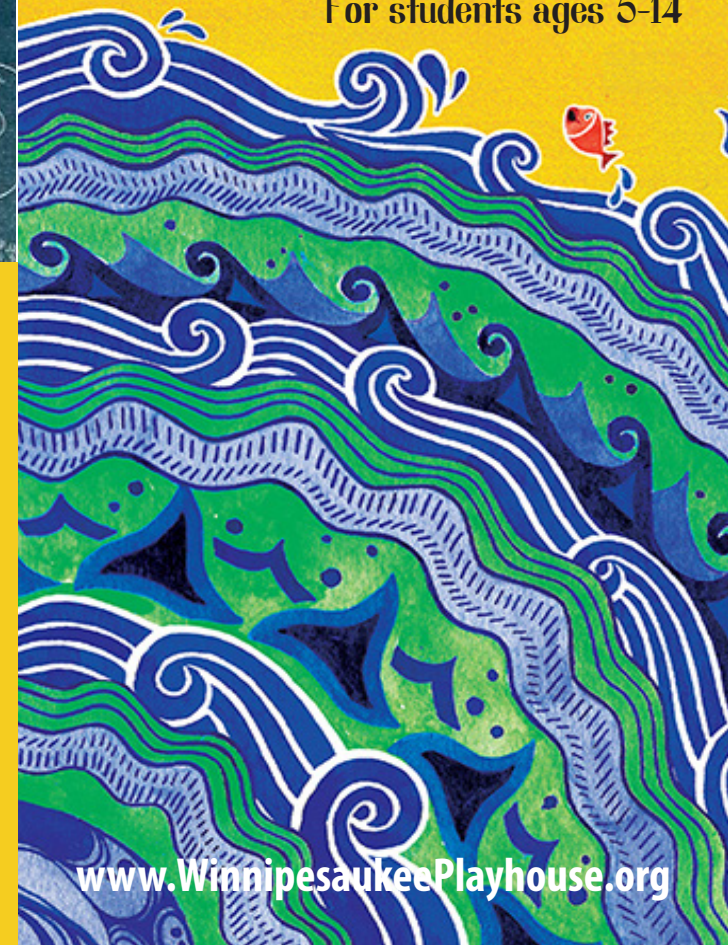

Fables, Legends, & Myths

Camps 1 and 2

Students age 5-11 (entering grades K-5)



Camp 1 (generally ages 5-8) continues the Playhouse's successful arts-integration approach. In the morning, students devise their own theatrical productions through play, improvisation, and storytelling. The afternoon brings beginner level workshops in art, dance, and music.

Camp 2 (generally ages 9-11) continues and extends the work done in Camp 1. In the morning, students have an increased role in creating and staging their performances. The afternoon offers intermediate level art, dance, and music workshops.

Each week, students will imagine and explore a different facet of the summer's overall theme. The week will culminate in a showcase performance for friends and family!

Students may attend the morning (9:00-12:00), the afternoon (1:00-4:00), or both (9:00-4:00).

Morning Session: 9:00-12:00 (Theatre)
Afternoon Session: 1:00-4:00 (Music, Dance, Art)
Full Day Session: 9:00-4:00 (Fully Integrated-Arts)
