ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Audio/General Technician operates the audio console for live mixing of sound during performances and works across multiple technical departments as needed during non-performance times. Daily or weekly assignments to specific shows and departments will be made by the Production Manager and/or Technical Director depending on each department's needs.

Essential Duties:

- Work across multiple technical departments each day as assigned, most often with Props, Lighting, Scenic, Sound.
- Participate in all load-ins and strikes.
- Perform show crew duties as Sound Engineer (A1), or as running crew, as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum Physical Requirements:

- This position requires the employee to hear, see, move freely, climb stairs and ladders, work safely at heights, and lift 50lbs or more.

Minimum industry specific qualifications:

- Experience working with basic power tools and hand tools.
- Experience hanging and focusing lighting instruments.
- Experience assisting with prop making and sourcing.
- Knowledge of, and experience with, audio consoles and audio mixing.
- Flexible to work across multiple departments as assigned.
- Willing to learn new skills.
- Use safe practices in the workplace and keep workspaces clean and organized.
- Strong organizational skills.

Minimum education/experience requirements:

- 1 year of professional experience in technical theatre preferred.
- It is preferable that all applicants have a valid driver's license.
