**ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Charge Scenic Artist is a member of the technical team and is responsible for executing the paint treatments/elevations created by the scenic designer for each theatrical production.

**Essential Duties:**

- Create samples from renderings, paint elevations, and reference materials while keeping a detailed log of procedures and recipes for future duplication.
- Execute required paint treatments for each theatrical production, in collaboration with and as directed by the Technical Director and the Scenic Designer. This may include painting/texturing of scenery, properties, and furniture.
- Assist in the repair of above-mentioned scenic elements during run of current production.
- Coordinate workspace on the shop floor with other crew to maintain workflow for all.
- Maintain a clean and organized workspace and materials.
- Participate in all load-ins and strikes.
- Serve as running crew for 1-2 productions per season. Specific show assignments are made by the Production Manager.
- Work within an established scenic budget, keep a log of all purchases/returns, and submit receipts in a timely manner.
- Occasionally supervise other technicians to assist with painting tasks.
- Other duties as assigned.

**QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS**

**Minimum Physical Requirements:**

- This position requires the employee to hear, see, move freely, climb stairs and ladders, work safely at heights, and lift 50lbs or more.

**Minimum industry specific qualifications:**

- Strong organizational skills and the ability to monitor multiple projects simultaneously.
- Experience interpreting scenic designs and paint elevations.
- Experience in paint mixing and scenic treatments including, but not limited to: faux finish, carving, texturing, ageing, distressing.
- Able to work with both household latex and scenic paints.
- Working knowledge of sculpting/carving foam.
- Able to work to deadlines in a fast-paced environment.

**Minimum education/experience requirements:**

- At least 1 year experience in scenic painting, OR a combination of training and experience that would provide the required knowledge, skill, and artistry.
- It is preferable that all applicants have a valid driver’s license.
