ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Scenic Carpenter works under the Technical Director and Assistant Technical Director to build or modify scenery for all productions. The ideal candidate will possess high-level theatrical carpentry skills, problem-solving abilities, and demonstrate proficiency in basic theatrical rigging and stage operations, as well as the safe operation of power tools.

Essential Duties:

- Construct scenery under the guidance of the Technical Director and Assistant Technical Director; this may also include the construction of properties and furniture as needed.
- Install and maintain scenery, rigging, and stage equipment.
- Assist in the repair of above-mentioned materials during run of current production.
- Serve as run crew on 2-3 productions per season.
- Participate in all load-ins and strikes.
- Participate in shop clean up and organization projects as assigned.
- Work within an established scenic budget, keep a log of all purchases and returns, and submit receipts in a timely manner.
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum Physical Requirements:

- This position requires the employee to hear, see, move freely, climb stairs and ladders, work safely at heights, and lift 50lbs or more.

Minimum industry specific qualifications:

- Strong organizational skills and ability to monitor multiple projects simultaneously.
- Knowledge of wood construction, fabrication techniques and scenic engineering.
- Demonstrated understanding of how to interpret construction drawings.
- Able to work independently as well as part of a team.
- Proficient in scenic carpentry, the safe operation of power tools, and basic theatrical rigging.

Minimum education/experience requirements:

- At least 1 year of experience in a scenic shop is preferred.
