

The award-winning Winnepesaukee Playhouse is looking for non-Equity Stage Managers to be part of our professional season on our beautiful 11-acre campus in Meredith, New Hampshire.

The Stage Manager tracks are designed to alternate so that SMs are able to focus on one production at a time.

Stage Manager 1 (May 30 – October 9)

Stage Manager of the productions that take place on our indoor stage: Noel Coward's *Private Lives*, *The Mousetrap*, Lionel Bart's *Oliver!*, *Murder for Two*.

Stage Manager 2 (June 13 – September 17)

Stage Manager of the productions that take place on our newly renovated outdoor amphitheatre: *The Complete Works of William Shakespeare (Abridged) [Revised]*, *Robin Hood*, *The Conference of the Birds*.

There is a weekly salary of \$400 plus we pay an additional week in recognition of the pre-planning and virtual production meetings required of stage managers prior to arrival. Housing, utilities, and workman's comp included.

The Winnepesaukee Playhouse COVID-19 Vaccination Requirements for Employment:

All employees who are eligible (according to age and medical condition) to be vaccinated against COVID-19 are required to be fully vaccinated. "Fully vaccinated" is defined as having received two doses of Pfizer or Moderna (plus two weeks) OR one dose of Johnson & Johnson plus (two weeks.). Those who are six months or more past these initial dose(s) will also be required to have a booster shot. Exemptions to this requirement will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
